

The Cornea, Cataract & Refractive Unit specializes in corneal, limbal and conjunctival reconstruction, microbial keratitis, keratoconus management and ocular surface disease. The supervising consultants are innovators in their areas of work, have pioneered new concepts and services and have international reputations.

The proposed start date is August 1st, 2024.



CRITERIA FOR CONSIDERATION

Applicants are expected to be able to demonstrate multidisciplinary team working and flexibility. Applicants need to be less than 35 years old and already GMC registered with a license to practice. The applicants should have clinical and surgical skills commensurate with the position, at senior trainee and above level.

PURPOSE OF JOB

- 1. To develop clinical and surgical skills to the level of an anterior segment subspecialist
- 2. To provide support for the Corneal and Ocular Surface Disease Service
- 3. To undertake research in Cornea, Refractive and Ocular Surface
- 4. To undertake cataract and anterior segment surgery, under supervision and independently
- 5. To provide training of junior colleagues
- 6. To provide a general ophthalmic service under the supervision of consultant staff
- 7. To participate in and supervise audit projects
- 8. To exchange ideas, skills and knowledge with team
